



- Cases are selected by State Licensing Board representatives
- All cases are reviewed and pretested by chiropractors and SMEs

- Post-exam committee review
- Key changes and form adjustments
- Determine slope and intercept for cut score
- Convert scores to scaled scores
- Review site comments
- Review candidates letters of concern
- Print and post scores
- Send score letters to candidates and transcripts to state licensing boards

### NBCE Part IV Exam Scoring

- □ All NBCE exams are reported as scaled scores from 125-800
