## \$2500 Essay Competition

## **Student Eligibility**

- 1. In good academic standing and enrolled in a US, CCE-accredited, chiropractic program at any time during 2019.
- 2. Essay is submitted by October 1, 2019.

## **Contest Instructions**

- 1. Submit an original essay on any topic of your choice, as long as the topic is relevant to chiropractic. These may include: history, philosophy, practice perspectives, jurisprudence/law, ethics, theory, sociology, politics, or social sciences.
- 2. To enter the competition, submit 2 items by email:
  - a. An original essay, submitted as a Word document. Length: no shorter than 1200 and no longer than 3000 words. Word count does not include references.
     Include title page with your name, cell phone, and email.
  - b. A letter from your registrar confirming enrollment and that you are in good academic standing in your chiropractic program.
- 3. Judging criteria: relevance to the chiropractic profession, scholarly style, writing quality, originality, and use of references. Announcements of winning essays will be made by December 31, 2019.
- 4. Only one essay is allowed per student per competition and only one author per essay. Students who submitted in the past but did not win may compete again with a new essay.
- 5. Email materials to NBCEstudentscholarship@gmail.com by October 1, 2019.
