



March 2020 Part III & PHT Exams Rescheduled

Due to the rapidly changing conditions associated with the COVID-19 situation, and after much consideration, we have decided to reschedule the March 2020 Part III and Physiotherapy exams. Our first priority is the safety of examinees and our staff who administer the exams. We balance our sense of responsibility to facilitate your journey towards licensure with an understanding of the negative impact exam cancellations can have on our examinees. Because of this, we will now focus our efforts towards **re-administering the exams on May 2nd and 3rd**. Under this plan, examinees will receive their scores around June 19th, which is prior to the May Part IV score release.

We assure you that we did not make this decision lightly. Much time has been spent communicating with Chiropractic Colleges, working diligently together to identify a solution to safely allow testing this weekend. Ultimately, due to the constantly changing federal and local government restrictions, and in consideration of the health and safety of the examinees and staff, we determined that the best solution was to reschedule for a future date. We apologize for this inconvenience, and ask for your understanding during this time of national emergency.

It is not necessary for you to take any action at this time. As we develop plans for re-administration, we encourage you to check for updates on mynbce.org/examinfo. Affected examinees will receive an email with additional information within the next two weeks. Due to a high volume of calls, chats, and emails, you may experience delays in reaching the NBCE. We appreciate your patience, and we will make information available on the website for quick and convenient access.
