

Palmer Chiropractic College-West (San Jose, CA campus only) July Part IV Site Location Change

Recent collaboration efforts have resulted in our ability to **move** the July 10-12 **Part IV** exam administration from **Palmer Chiropractic College – West Campus in San Jose, CA to Life Chiropractic College West in Hayward, CA**. All examinees who were scheduled to take Part IV July 10-12 at Palmer Chiropractic College -West campus are now scheduled for the same dates and times at Life Chiropractic College West in Hayward, CA.

Please note, this will not be reflected on your application through your online account. It is your responsibility to use caution and judgement before deciding to travel to or attend the test administration. Please do not travel or attend if you are sick. We are hopeful for the ability to test at Life West in July, but due to the ever-changing local, state, and federal mandates, as well as test site availability, we may have to make additional decisions around testing. We recommend checking the webpage before leaving for your testing appointment to ensure there has not been a cancellation.

If you cannot attend an exam administration due to travel restrictions, disagreement with social distancing protocols, test site policy, or health reasons, you may cancel or reschedule your appointment to a future administration by emailing us at support@nbce.org with your request to withdraw from the exam and whether you want to apply your fees to a future administration or receive a refund.

COVID-19 has brought us many logistical challenges over the past several months and it is only through the hard work, cooperation, and support of chiropractic college leadership, their facilities teams, test site staff, vendor partners, and the dedicated staff of the NBCE that we have been able to continue testing.
