



NBCE Eligibility Policy

(Adopted November 2, 2006)

Applications will be accepted from otherwise eligible individuals enrolled in or graduates of a doctor of chiropractic degree program, or its equivalent, that is accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education United States, or any other specialized accrediting agency recognized by the United States Secretary of Education to accredit doctor of chiropractic degree programs, or a chiropractic accrediting agency that is approved by the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners, Board of Directors (Board), or from individuals enrolled in a doctor of chiropractic program or its equivalent, that has regional accreditation and is actively pursuing accreditation (i.e. has candidate status) with a chiropractic accrediting agency approved by the Board.

The chiropractic accrediting agencies currently approved by the Board are:

- C. European Council on Chiropractic Education
